Inspired by the designs she saw, Pam believed that she too could create quilts using the sewing and photography skills she already had. "I didn't ever intend to become a quilter, it just evolved," Pam admits.

She continues, "Teaching is an absolute passion. Who needs drugs when you've got quilting! I absolutely love teaching and I never, ever imagined that I would."

"I really like to inspire people. There are a lot of teachers that will just teach the basics, and that's fine. In the classes I teach I like people to look at things totally differently, to look at their surroundings, their environment, the colors in the environment and to be able to take something they see and put it in their quilt."
